

Call for Participation in the fourth Nordic GeoGebra conference

We hereby invite contributions to the fourth Nordic GeoGebra conference which will be held in Copenhagen in September 20. – 22. 2013. The main themes of the conference are:

- Using GeoGebra throughout the educational system. From primary school to higher education.
- 3D in GeoGebra.
- Screencast technology and GeoGebra.

We welcome contributions by teacher and researchers either in the form of a talk (20 - 30 min.) presenting practice or research that relates to ICT in the teaching of mathematics, or in the form of a workshop (90 min.) on the use of GeoGebra or other software.

At the conference a special topic group on learning mathematics through screencast technology and video will work on video and screencast as a method for strengthening the teaching and learning of mathematics.
